Global Spotlight (Japan)

Steven MacWhinnie, Associate Professor at Hirosaki Gakuin University in Aomori, Japan, shares how connection inside the JET community turns showing up into belonging — for students, schools, and new JETs alike.

"In Japan, teachers are often reassigned to new schools every few years, and starting fresh can be challenging. Each transfer also carries unseen threads of connection. When familiar teachers from past schools appear in a new staff room, those shared experiences create instant belonging. It's a reminder that connection isn't limited to a single place: It moves with us and helps new communities take root."

Why it matters: Connection is the bridge between preparation and thriving. It's how applicants become community members, and how classrooms become places of shared growth.



Practical Wisdom

Our growth is shaped not only by what we learn, but by what we apply. Try one of these quick practices this week to strengthen your sense of connection.

<u>3–2–1 Reach-Out:</u> Send 3 quick check-ins, 2 thank-yous, and 1 ask for advice (2–3 sentences each).

<u>Micro-Belonging Moves:</u> Use names, share one win, and share one need in your next meeting or study group.

<u>Learn → Debrief:</u> Attend a consulate/USJETAA webinar, then 15-minute debrief with a peer. Capture 3 insights + 1 next step.
